Weekly REACH:

- Look for ways that your children are serving and give them positive praise.
- Talk about ways that God was great in your lives each night at dinner.

Stand: Sing Kid's Songs

Sit: Lesson – The Greatest Year

Read 2 Corinthians 13:5a

Q: Are there any areas in our family where Christ is missing? Have a frank and honest discussion with your spouse and children.

Q: How would our family be greater if God was in everything we did?

Read John 3:30 and explain

Q: What does this say about God?

Q: What does this say about us?

Q: What will we do about it?

On Bellies: Each person say one thing they will change to make themselves less and God greater.

Talk about how those things will help the whole family in 2016

Games: Reverse War - Have everyone pick a card from a deck of cards. The one with the lowest card wins. War if there is a tie. Pass around a "trophy" for the winner of each round.

Big to little: Start by saying the name of a really big object and then go around the room saying slightly smaller things until you can't anymore.
